



ON CAMPUS COVID-19 POLICIES

Attestations

Prior to returning back onto AAPS campus, all students and staff members must sign-off on a **COVID-19 Attestation Form**. Any member who does not sign-off on the COVID-19 Attestation Form will not be permitted to enter the premise of any AAPS campus. Attestation forms are signed again every 14 days.

Expectations

All students and staff on campus must follow AAPS' COVID-19 policies at all times. Policies will be revised on a regular basis as needed.

- Due to the evolving symptoms of the virus, students, faculty and staff who are feeling in any way unwell should not attend the school until tested.
- Maintain social distancing of 6-feet (2m) on campus. Failure to comply may lead to the removal from the premises.
- Hand sanitizer must be used upon entry. This includes anyone who is returning from the washroom or hallways.
- Face masks and coverings must be worn on the premises.
- Guests of students, faculty and staff are not permitted on campus at this time.
- Washroom keys must be disinfected upon each use.

Safeguards

To ensure the safety of our staff and students on campus, AAPS will be implementing the following measures:

- Arrival times are staggered to facilitate physical distancing upon entry at the start of day for faculty, staff and learners.
- Hand sanitizers are available upon entry at the front desk.
- Upon each student's first entry, temperatures are taken by an admin staff.
- Non-surgical face masks will be provided if needed. Please consider that the college will have a limited supply. To help our community, try to bring your own face mask/coverings if possible.
- Social distancing markers are setup in classrooms and the laboratory to ensure safe physical distance is maintained.
- AAPS will regularly sanitize surfaces of the campus, especially high contact areas such as door handles, light switches, table surfaces, computer keyboards, etc.
- Maximum capacity of 10 persons in any room.

- The kitchen is limited to a maximum of 2 occupants at any given time. The water station will be out of service, so please be prepared and bring your own beverage and refreshments.
- Signage is posted around the campus to remind everyone on good hygiene and social distancing practice.
